	As part of the Cycle Sweep team you will ride the route to support riders with mechanics, directions and first aid assistance. You will have the necessary skills to assist cyclists with simple bike maintenance issues such as changing a tube or using a gas cylinder.

Duties and Responsibilities	Ride alongside the riders and provide support to any participant who requires assistance
	Ensure participants are cycling safely and in accordance with the event guidelines
	Double back on the route to provide continued support across the event

Skills and Qualifications	This role is suited only to experienced cyclists who can cover up to 200km
	Must have your own working bike and helmet
	Demonstrated understanding of basic bike mechanics and cycling laws
	Outstanding communication skills
	First aid training desired, but not essential
